Every class recognized by the Maine Hunter Jumper Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of MeHJA.

**SHOW RULES:**

- Asterisks classes qualify as USHJA Outreach Classes - Please go to USHJA website for details
- Hunter Breeding Horses/Ponies will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the MEHJA
- No horse may enter a class unless an entry blank has been completed, fees paid, and number assigned. \*\*\*Note: Any returned checks will be subject to a \$25 returned check fee, in addition to the amount of the check and any bank fees incurred by MeHJA.
- Entry fees will be as follows:
  - \$15 per all classes, medal, stakes and championships.
  - \$20 for all hunter derby classes and the MeHJA Schooling Jumper Class.
  - There will be a \$10 post entry fee per horse/rider combination.
  - Entries will close on Wed. July 13 2022.
- Show Ring is a sand ring. Separate warm-up area will be available and is also a sand ring.
- Food will be available on the grounds. Lunch break, if any, will be announced.
- No refunds unless you have a note from the veterinarian or medical doctor.
- No dogs allowed on the grounds unless leashed and kept away from the ring.
- Warm-up will be held from 6:30a-8:15a in the show ring. Jumps will be set at 2'3", then changed to cross rails halfway through. There will be a \$10 warm up fee per horse/rider combination. Warm-up tickets are available at the Secretary's booth. Ticket must be handed to gate keeper

prior to entry. No more than 4 riders at a time in the show ring warm-up. Trainers limited to 4 riders and up to 5 minutes overall in the warm-up. **Classes begin promptly at 8:30a.**

- The schooling Hunter/Equitation classes will be open to Junior and Adult Amature Exhibitors.
- Medal Specifications will be available at the secretary's booth.
- Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
- Show Management reserves the right to refuse any entry or request the removal of any entry or person on the grounds without being liable.
- Formal Protests - If a rider, trainer or spectator would like to file a formal protest - protests must be filed, in writing, within 7 days of the violation to the show manager and must include a \$50 deposit. The show manager will then submit the protest to the MeHJA for judgement. Please see the MeHJA Rulebook.
- Championship and Stakes Classes: To be eligible, horse or rider (in equitation classes), must have entered, shown and been judged in the class in parenthesis ( )
- Championship and Reserve Championship Ribbons will be awarded in the following divisions:
  - Easy Does It
  - Thoroughbred Hunter
  - Schooling Hunter
  - Low Hunter
  - Special Working Hunter
  - Pre-Green Hunter
  - Children's Working Hunter
- Proof of current negative Coggins and Rabies are required (For in-state horses, dated within 36 month of show date. For out of state horses, dated within 6 months of show date)
- Hunter Derby Classes are not MeHJA pointed
- **\*\*NEW\*\*** MeHJA Bo Dutton Memorial Pleasure Class- *W/T/C flat class to be judged on the pony/horse's manners, movement and way of going. Pony/Horse should move freely, be well behaved and demonstrate the qualities of a true field hunter. All proceeds to benefit the MeHJA Bo Dutton Memorial Medical Fund.*
- MeHJA Show Committee, its agents or employees, or the Hollis Equestrian park will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to rider, groom, attendant, spectator, animal, or equipment at the show.
