- 1 All classes recognized by Maine Hunter/Jumper Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of MeHJA. Classes with a (**) are not pointed or rated by MeHJA.
- 2 All classes recognized by Downeast Medal Finals will be conducted and judged under the current rules of DMF.
- 3 Six ribbons awarded per class, trophy/prize as indicated.
- 4 No rider may enter a class unless entry form has been completed, fees paid and number assigned.
- 5 Entry fees as follows: \$15 per regular class, \$20 per stakes, medal and championship classes. There will be a post entry fee of \$10 per horse and rider combination applied to entries received after July 15th. Unjudged warm up in show arena \$10.
- 6 To be eligible for Stakes classes, horse must have entered and shown in its respective over fences class. Championship classes rider must have entered and shown in division classes.
- 7 Champion and Reserve will be awarded for the following divisions: Leadline; Walk Trot; Short Stirrup; Easy Does It; Schooling Hunter; Schooling Equitation; Special Hunter; Children's Hunter and Low Hunter based on points
- 8 No refunds without note from veterinarian or medical doctor
- 9 Show ring is 100x200 stone dust/sand outdoor arena, schooling area is 70x90 sand ring which will be open throughout the day. Jumping warmups will be held in the show ring at designated times.
- 10 All horses outside of rings must be kept at a walk at all times
- 11 At the discretion of the Judge, any horse out of control will be excused from the class. At the discretion of the Judge, any horse in pain will be excused from the class.
- 12 All ring fences must be kept clear of any items or tack. Horses may not be tied to fences
- 13 All dogs must be leashed and kept away from arenas and barn area
- 14 Parking in the CK Equestrian parking lot is reserved for CKE Staff and show officials. All others must park at the main building. Parking for trailers will be in the upper field, please park in designated area and clean up after your horses.
