High Point Thoroughbred Hunter & High Point Thoroughbred Jumper

Un-judged warm-ups from 7am - 8:15am in the show ring. Jumps set to 2'3' followed by cross rails. Classes will begin promptly at 8:30 A.M.

SHOW RULES:

- This show is MeHJA and TIP Affiliated and will be offering Downeast Medal and MeHJA medal classes. Membership applications to all organizations are available with at the secretary's booth and must be filled out prior to the start of the show if rider wishes to compete for points.
- No horse may enter a class unless an entry blank has been completed, fees paid, and number assigned. ***Note: Any returned checks will be subject to a \$25 returned check fee, in addition to the amount of the check and any bank fees incurred by Life's A Ride.
- Entry fees will be as follows:
 - \$15 per all classes
 - \$20 per Medal Class
 - There will be a \$10 post entry fee per horse/rider combination that enters day of show.
- All Hunter Classes will be held in the sand ring. All Jumper classes will be held on Grass.
- Jumper Ring results will be calculated using an electronic timer per the MeHJA Rules.
- In the case of rain, Show management reserves the right to move some or all of the hunter classes into the indoor, as needed, for rider safety. Updates will be provided on the FB Event Pg.
- Hunter Warm-up will be held from 7a-8:15a in the show ring. Jumps will be set at 2'3", then changed to cross rails halfway through. No more than 4 riders at a time in the warm-up. Trainers limited to 4 riders and up to 5 minutes overall in the warm-up. **Classes begin promptly at 8:30a.**
- Once the show has started, riders will have the ability to warm up in the indoor or in the field area next to the jumper ring.
- Medal and Class Specifications will be available at the secretary's booth. MeHJA Rule book also available at the Secretary's booth
- Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.

- Proof of current negative Coggins and Rabies are required (For in-state horses, dated within 36 month of show date. For out of state horses, dated within 6 months of show date)
- **ALL** Riders must wear a ASTM Approved Helmet anytime mounted.
- Show Management reserves the right to refuse any entry or request the removal of any entry or person on the grounds without being liable.
- Formal Protests - If a rider, trainer or spectator would like to file a formal protest - protests must be filed, in writing, within 7 days of the violation to the show manager and must include a \$50 deposit. The show manager will then submit the protest to the MeHJA for judgement. Please see the MeHJA Rulebook.
- **No dogs are allowed anywhere on the grounds**
- Please clean up after your horse in the parking area prior to leaving the show.
- Any adds/drops can be made with either the in-gate person or at the secretary's booth. Any no-shows will be charged for the missed class. Riders are responsible for making their classes on time. If a rider needs a hold on a class - please let the Secretary or in-gate person know within 2 classes prior to the needed hold.
- No Obscene language - Please remember that we have riders of all ages and backgrounds at this facility.
